This fall, twelve Medeco and Arrow employees participated in a Six Sigma Green Belt training class. A Green Belt is an employee of an organization who has been trained on the improvement methodology of Six Sigma and will lead a process improvement or quality improvement team as part of their full time job.



During the class, mornings were spent learning principles of Six Sigma in detail and afternoons entailed a six sigma improvement project simulation.

Additionally, small teams were developed to choose a current process within their daily work and develop a potential improvement plan. During the project simulation, the employees were divided into two teams to do research, develop a solution, and present it to a mock company president.
