ASSA ABLOY Territory Manager Donates Kidney, Saves Life

Lisa Augerson, a Territory Manager for Medeco, Arrow, and other ASSA ABLOY companies in southern California donated one of her kidneys on Monday, August 3rd to Dennis McCarthy. Lisa and Dennis met while watching their daughters play softball together, which is where Lisa learned Dennis had been undergoing dialysis treatments and on waiting lists for a new kidney for over a year. In October of 2008, Lisa found that she was the same blood type, offered to get tested, and found there were enough common markers to make her a candidate for donation. Lisa and Dennis are now positively recovering; in fact, Lisa continued to help her customers obtain Medeco and Arrow products during her first weeks of recovery! Lisa says she is so thankful life presented her with such a great opportunity to help save another person's life.



During her research into the donation process, Lisa learned that over 12,000 people die each year waiting for a new kidney. The waiting list for a cadaver kidney is as long as seven years!



Although the testing process to donate a kidney takes six months to a year, Lisa felt it was worth every minute of her time. According to the University of Maryland Medical Center and many other resources, donating a kidney (therefore living with one) does not effect the donor's life



expectancy or likelihood of developing kidney problems. Lisa says, "I advise people to be open to it. Helping the McCarthy family is a lifelong reward and I am so thankful to have been given the opportunity to do this. It is well worth any recovery time and effort."

We are thankful to work with such a giving individual and wish her and Dennis a speedy and healthy remainder of their recovery.

KeyMark x4 LFIC Retrofit for Sargent Hardware

The KeyMark x4 Sargent style LFIC is now available. This cylinder complements KeyMark x4 LFIC cylinders for Yale, Corbin Russwin and Sargent hardware giving the KeyMark line the most extensive LFIC retrofit capability in the patented key control market.

Sargent LFIC Product Details:

The 32N2401 KeyMark x4 Sargent style LFIC is packaged with two tailpieces for use with Sargent lever locksets. The tailpieces have one shortened leg to clear the slider. Tailpiece CT-V52, marked "H7", is for use with Sargent 10 Line locksets. Tailpiece CT-V53, marked "L7" is for use with Sargent 11 Line locksets. These tailpieces are also available as part of Tailpiece Package 94-0268.



For Sargent mortise and rim housings manufactured prior to October, 2008 it is necessary to remove a portion of the drive pin on the slider side of the housing before installing the core.

For shortening the drive pin we've created a drive pin cut-off tool, CP-286851. Sargent mortis and rim housings manufactured after October, 2008 are made with drive pin lengths that are compatible with KeyMark x4 cores.
